
## August Newsletter

rides, games, pool, and refreshments... Please check in with Mary Ellen & Christina at Pavilion Vato receive these tickets.



# The Vine and Branches



In the Gospel of St. John Chapter 15 verse 5 Jesus states that "I am the vine and you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." You do not have to know much about gardening and plants to realize that a tree, shrub or any plant depends on the trunk and the root system for it to flourish and be healthy. To use the imagery of Jesus, you might say that the trunk of the vine is the "Jesus trunk" because without it the vine is dead. Another imagery would be, our family tree, the trunk is our parents and great-grandparents and we are the branches, we are connected to that "trunk" by blood, much in the same way we are connected to the vine of Jesus by faith and baptism. In baptism water was poured over us and we were grafted into the vine who is Jesus himself. We intimetly became connected to him, by his death and resurrection, and received from him all that we need to sustain our lives. We are connected to him when we attend Sunday Worship, and when he hear his word, and receive him in Holy Eucharist. As branches of the true vine, we are kept healthy and alive, and we are connected to the source of life. Whether we talk about being "connected", "abiding", "remaining" or "being joined" one thing is clear, being connected to Christ is crucial. It is the only way to a complete life. So let strive to live everday of our life by this Gospel verse, and remain connected to that "true" vine, not only when we are down or in need of His help in the midst of the storms of our everday life but always, for without the vine and our connection to Jesus himself we are nothing. When we cut ourself off from his love and the church we become withered and we die. So remain connected to the true vine so that you will bear much fruit.
