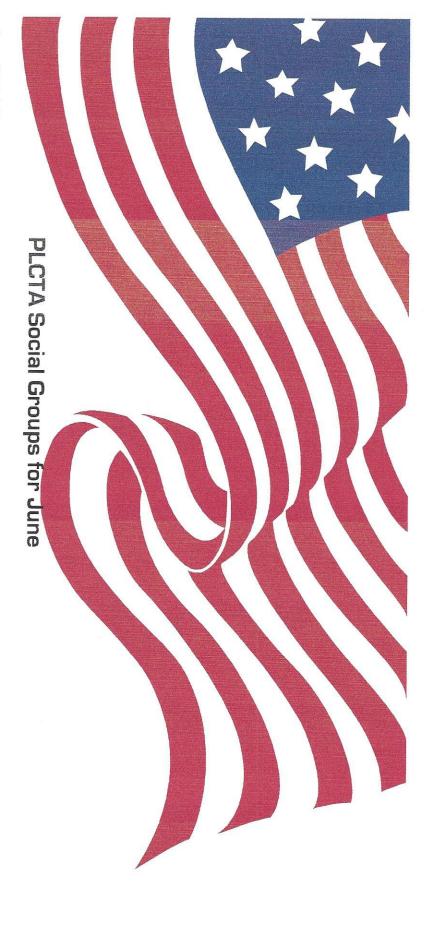
As another school year comes to an end, I would like to wish everyone a great summer. Make some lasting memories!!!!

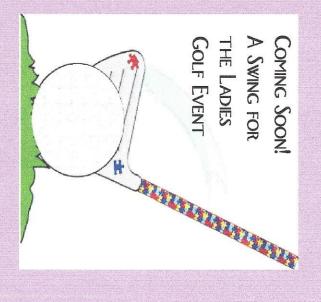

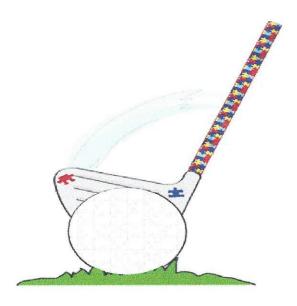
