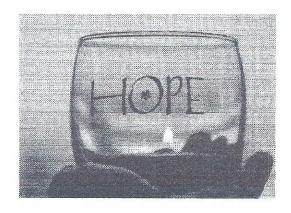

Many of us might remember the 1988 song by Bobby McFerrin entitled Don't Worry Be Happy. This song had calmed so many troubled nerves and worried minds. The song gives us a message that both offers instruction and encouragement: "don't worry!" The question that follows this immediately is: "can we actually not worry?" Even McFerrin knew when he was writing that "worry" is a significant part of human reality. It is almost unrealistic ordinarily not to worry about many things especially when we are not sure what comes next. We are a people of worry, we worry about: finances, health, marriage, family members, our spouse, and children. The gospel of St. Matthew 6:25 tells us "Do not worry about your life, what you are to eat or drink; or about what you are to wear." Easier said than done, we are what they call a worry wart. Recent studies indicate that over 85% of all that we worry about never happens. These include worries over our past which can never be changed, worries over which we have no control, irrational concerns or fears, and future worries. God created various trees, flowers and plants of which these were created not to worry, however, God created human beings to worry. We will never be able to escape from worry, however, there is a remedy that when we begin to worry we can just remember the words of Bobby McFerrin "Give you my number, when you worry call me, I will make you happy." These words can be of so much comfort to us who worry on a daily basis.
